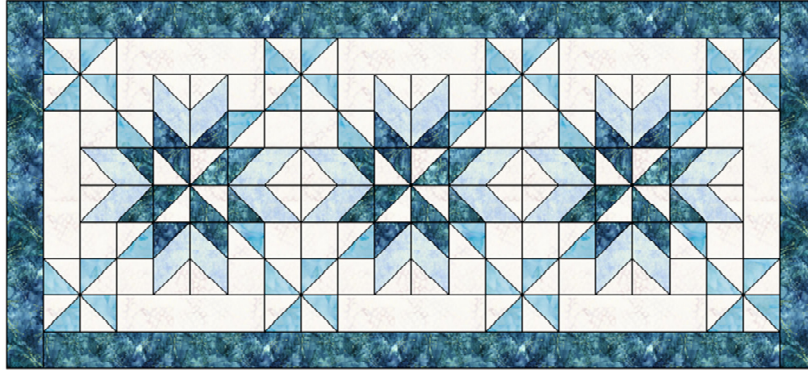


Ice Crystals



Quilt Finishes 33" x 15"

Fabric Requirements:

- Background 5/8 yard
- Dark 1/3 yard
- Medium fat quarter
- Accent fat quarter
- Binding 1/3 yard

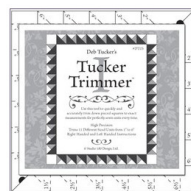
This pattern is also very conducive to using fat quarters (or even scraps if you have a collection). If scrapping, I suggest using a separate dark, medium and accent for each block.

Recommended (optional) Tools and Rulers:

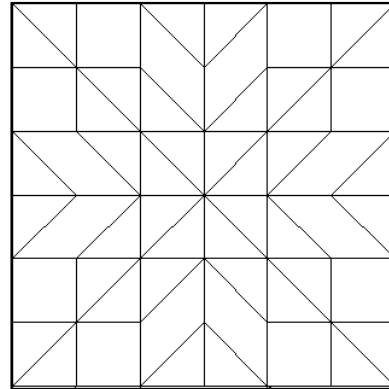
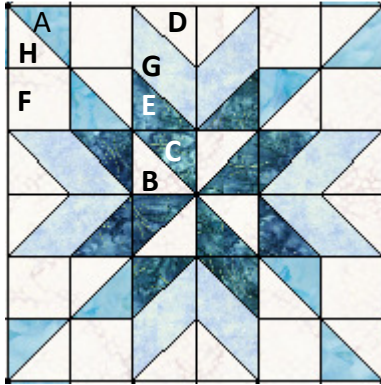
Deb Tucker's Tucker Trimmer 1™ from Studio 180 Design used to easily trim down units that are made with triangles - half square triangle squares and quarter square triangle squares (hourglass units).

Perfect Corner Ruler from Forever In Stitches, LLC. gives you an accurate sewing line along with oversized pieces that can be trimmed down on folded corner types of units.

If you cannot locate the specialty rulers, separate instructions are provided for cutting pieces and for using your favorite square-up ruler to do the suggested trim-downs. To do so, place Invisigrip™ on the wrong side of your ruler. Use a Sharpie fine line marker to mark the guidelines per the instructions in the pattern.

Cutting Chart for One Block – Make 3 blocks for table runner

Piece	Fabric	Size of Patch	# per block
A	Accent	2-1/2" □	4
B	Background	2-1/2" □	2
C	Dark	2-1/2" □	2
D	Background	2-3/4" □	4
E	Dark	2-3/4" □	4
F	Background	2" □	8
G	Medium	2" x 3-1/2"	8
H	Background	2-1/2" □	4

Setting Cutting Chart

Piece	Fabric	Size of Patch	# Required
I - Sashing	Background	2" x 6-1/2"	8
J – Cornerstone Half Square Triangle Units	Background	2-1/2" □	10
K– Cornerstone Half Square Triangle Units	Accent	2-1/2" □	10
L – Border Sides	Dark	2" x 30-1/2"	2
M – Border Top/Bottom	Dark	2" x 15-1/2"	2
