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Half Square Triangles

• Place Light and Dark pieces (A and Es for large blocks and C and Hs for small blocks) right sides together. On wrong side of Light draw a diagonal line corner to corner. Stitch 1/4" from drawn line on both sides











Stem Section

- Press the small square toward upper left corner.
- Repeat with another G on lower right corner. These are for the Large Maple Leaf Blocks.
- Optional trim the middle layer of fabric ¹/₄" from the seam











• Repeat with piece Js on Stem Os. These are for the small Maple Leaf Blocks.











- Combine half square triangle units, stem units and remaining squares in rows per diagram.
- Combine rows.








